The workshop is based on research findings on innovative assessment practices by the University of Western Australia's Dr Sandy Heldsinger and Dr Stephen Humphrey. The workshop will be led by Dr Heldsinger and ACER Research Fellow Rob Hassell.

Research shows that effective teachers who have a strong, positive impact on student learning are proficient assessors who use data to inform their teaching. These teachers also collaborate with their colleagues who teach at a similar year level to improve their understanding of what assessment shows about student learning.

This workshop will ask participants to collect their own data and provide the opportunity to:

- develop an understanding of how to use and trust their own judgements to drive student learning;
- reflect on how they can make the most of the data they collect;
- ensure all their assessment activity leads to improved student learning; and
- collaborate to develop and refine their assessment skills.

Participants will learn about current developments in assessment and school evaluation, and how to best apply this knowledge to classroom practices.
